4. National Equestrian Championship: All athletes having Indian Nationality are allowed to participate in the National Championship. However, a foreign rider is allowed to take part in regional horse shows but in the National Championship He/She can participate as an HC Entry.

## Article 210

3. No two medals will be awarded for the same event.
