

MINUTES OF 54TH ANNUAL GENERAL BODY MEETING OF EQUESTRIAN FEDERATION OF INDIA HELD ON 27TH SEP 2015 AT DEFENCE SERVICES OFFICERS' INSTITUTE, DHAULA KUAN, NEW DELHI

1. The 54th Annual General Body Meeting of Equestrian Federation of India was held on 27th Sep 2015 at Defence Services Officers' Institute, Dhaula Kuan, New Delhi under the Chairmanship of Lt Gen Rajiv Vasant Kanitkar, SM, VSM President EFI. The meeting was attended by 218 members.

2. **Opening address by the President**

2.1 The President welcomed all the present members to 54th Annual General Body meeting of EFI. He emphasized that more efforts are required to be put in by all concerned in a coordinated manner for development of the sports. He stated that officials who are elected have an important responsibility to perform, we need to have more tournaments, greater experience and coaching, better infrastructure and transparent selection procedure. A combined effort is required between regions and zones. He further stated that capability to win medals can be realized only if everyone works for national and international glory. He requested all members to participate in AGM in a sober, dignified manner and give constructive suggestions.
