REGIONAL EQUESTRIAN LEAGUE AT CHENNAI
FROM 16TH TO 18TH OCTOBER 2020

1. **ADMINISTRATIVE INSTRUCTIONS**

The Regional Equestrian League 2020 for JNEC is being organised from 16th to 18th October 2020 at Chennai Equitation Centre, Chennai.

2. **JNEC- REL CATEGORIES**

- (a) Children II Dressage & Show Jumping
- (b) Children I Dressage & Show Jumping
- (c) Junior Dressage & Show Jumping

3. **SCHEDULE OF EVENTS**

See Annexe A.

4. **ENTRIES**

- (a) All entries will be on a proper Entry Form as provided in Annexe B.
- (b) Entries not on the prescribed entry form or without entry fee will not be considered.
- (c) Entry fee will need to be paid for each competition:
 - (i) Individual Entry: Rs.500/-
 - (ii) Individual Post Entry: Rs.1,000/ -
- (d) Closing Date for Entries: 14th October at 12 Noon. Post that date will be considered late entry.
- (e) All entries fees must be paid in cash, bank transfer or local cheque in favour of "Chennai Equitation Centre."

5. REGISTRATION

Horses and Riders must be registered with EFI. Team captains are requested to ensure that their horses are all registered before submitting Entries for the Events. The registration Number has to be recorded in the Entry Form as per EFI rules. Entries will not be accepted without EFI registration number.

6. WITHDRAWAL, CHANGE, TRANSFER OR SUBSTITUTIONS OF ENTRY

(a) The Entry fee of a horse entered for any category will not be refunded if the horse does not participate in the class.

(b) Additional entry fee will be payable for a change in a Rider or Horse the class to which it is transferred.

(c) A horse once entered in any category cannot be substituted by another horse for any reason

7. All horses must display the EFI Registration Number on the bridle during competition and the veterinary inspection and whenever taken out of the stable under the saddle.

8. No ROSETTES will be worn by a horse during judging.

9. ELIMINATION/DISQUALIFICATION: Judges are empowered to disqualify a competitor at any stage of the competition for rough handling, excessive brutality or any form of cruelty to animals. Rapping will be severely penalised. Refer to Article 243 FEI Rules for Jumping Events 2009.

10. WHIPS/SPURS: As per EFI and relevant FEI rules per discipline.

11. DRESS CODE: Riders are expected to wear riding boots, white breeches, a white or lightly coloured plain shirt, white tie and Jacket must be worn.

12. APPEAL: Appeals can be lodged by competitors within two hours before the commencement of any class and within half an hour after announcement of the result. A fee of Rs.2000/- (Rupees Two Thousand only) should be deposited with the Show Secretary along with the objection. Money will be refunded if the objection is upheld.

13. MEDICAL COVER: CEC will only provide basic medical facility for riders at the venue. CEC shall not accept any liability for medical treatment given to a competitor on the venue or the consequences thereof. It will be the responsibility of the individual/team to give a written undertaking absolving CEC of any responsibility in this regard. CEC will only provide first-aid emergency treatment as well as evacuation to the hospital.

14. INSURANCE: The Organizing Committee recommends units/clubs/associations to take insurance policies for competitors, personnel, grooms and horses for their transportation to CEC and during the events.

15. RESPONSIBILITY: The Organising Committee will assume no responsibility for any accident or illness due to fall of any horse, competitors, groom/any other member of the team. The Organising Committee accepts no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury to any animal or any other property or the exhibitors themselves. Neither the Committee nor the Doctor will be held responsible for any first aid or other medical treatment provided.

16. CAMPING AND ACCOMMODATION

(a) The camp opens on 10th October and camp closes on 20th October.

(b) All teams should come fully equipped with their own tent age for Stabling, and enough grain and fodder for the duration of the show. Cost of renting one stable area of 12 x 12 feet is Rs. 500/- for the duration of the Competition. In case teams want temporary stables, it can be arranged with our contractor with an additional fee of Rs.2,500/- . All teams that require stables must communicate their requirement by 4th October.

(c) The Organisers will try to arrange for bedding straw and fodder to be made available for sale at retail prices.

(d) All teams must inform the organisers of their total strength (personnel and animals) by 4th October, so that camp sites of appropriate size can be allocated for all teams, both civilian and government.

(e) All teams must inform the organisers of their estimated time of arrival well in advance.

(f) All bio-degradable waste including horse dung is to be properly disposed of in the compost heap.

- (g) All plastic and paper waste is to be put into the dustbins provided.
- (h) Please minimise your use of plastic materials.
- (i) No open fires are permitted on CEC grounds.
- (j) Cutting of trees, branches, bushes is strictly prohibited

17. COGGINS AND GLANDERS TEST

All rules to be followed from the EFI and Remount Veterinary Directorate, Army Headquarters on the subject will be strictly adhered to by all concerned. All horses must produce a valid negative EIA and Glanders status (CFT or Mallein) certificate before or upon arrival in Chennai. Coggins and Glanders negative certificate with a validity of a minimum of 15 days on arrival and exit of horses from the camp is mandatory.

18. COVID-19 PROTOCOL.

In light of the COVID-19 pandemic, strict protocols and guidelines must be followed in order to ensure a safe and successful conduct of the event. The guidelines for resuming equestrian training and competition activities in a COVID-19 environment issued by the EFI will be strictly adhered to.
