NATIONAL TENT PEGGING (NEC) CHAMPIONSHIP,

WORLD CUP QUALIFIER TENT PEGGING

01 March – 15 March 2021

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. The NEC Tent Pegging will be conducted according to the Rules of the Equestrian Federation of India (EFI) and ITPF Rules by Equiwings Sports & Events (P) Ltd at the Gautam Buddha University Sports Stadium, Greater Noida (NCR) as per programme enclosed.

2. **Classes:** Details of each class are given at **Appendix 'A' and 'B'**.

3. Entries :-

(a) All entries will be on a proper Entry Form as given in **Appendix 'C'**. Entries not on the prescribed entry form or entry form not accompanied with entry fee will not be considered. ALL ENTRIES MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY BIRTH CERTIFICATES/EFI RIDER ID. ONLINE Entries can be submitted on info@equiwings.com.

(b) Entry Fee :-

- (i) Team Events : Rs. 1000/- per team
- (ii) Individual Events : Rs. 500/- per exhibit

(c) **Closing Date for Entries** : Entries will close by **01 March 2021**. Entries received thereafter will be regarded as **POST ENTRIES**. No entry will be accepted without an entry fee.

(d) **Post Entries:** Post entries will be accepted twenty four hours before the event. Post P_entry fee will be :-

- (i) Team Events : Rs. 2000/- per team
- (ii) Individual Events : Rs. 1000/- per exhibit

4. **Description and Registration of Horses:** All entries must give the description, EFI Registration No and name of the horse concerned. The name of the rider will be given for all mounted classes.

5. EFI Horses Passport.

(i) As per EFI rules ALL horses participating in the National Equestrian Championship (NEC) have to be in possession of EFI passport.

(ii) No entry will be accepted without EFI registration No. For further information pertaining to registration, contact EFI at 011-25683601. Please register the horses participating in the event with the EFI prior to the show.

6. **EFI RIDER ID** : All Participants of NEC Tent Pegging MUST have a Valid EFI Rider ID

7. **Payments:** All entries must be paid in **cash** or by DD in favour of :-
“Equiwings Sports & Events (P) Ltd”, payable at New Delhi.

8. **Withdrawal of Entry :-**

The Entry fee of a horse entered for any event will not be refunded if the horse/rider does not participate in the class.

9. **Cancellation:** The Organising Committee may cancel any class which has less than four entries, or for any reason at their discretion. In that case, the entry fee will be refunded.
10. **Eliminations:** Eliminations may be held depending on the number of entries received.
11. **Reporting for Each Class:** All horses will report to the Collecting Ring Steward half an hour before the time of judging of the class. Any entry not reporting in time will be eliminated.
12. **Show Number:** All horses will display the EFI Registration Number on the bridle during competition and veterinary inspection and whenever taken out of the stable under the saddle.
13. **Appeal:** Appeal can be lodged by competitors within one hour before the commencement of any class and within one hour after announcement of the result. A fee of Rs. 2000/- (Rupees Two Thousand Only) should be deposited with the Organising Secretary – Equiwings, along with the objection. Money will be refunded if the objection is upheld.
14. **Responsibility:** The Organising Committee accepts no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury to any animal or any other property or the exhibitors themselves. Neither the Committee nor the Doctor will be held responsible for any first aid or other medical treatment provided.
15. **Cruelty to Animals:** The judges are empowered to disqualify the competitors at any stage of the competition for rough handling, excessive brutality or any form of cruelty to animals. Rapping will be severely penalized.
16. **Whips/Spurs:** As per EFI and relevant FEI rules per discipline.
17. **HORSE SELECTION FOR WORLD CUP QUALIFIER TENT PEGGING CHAMPIONSHIP 2021:** Every participating Team/Unit/Club/Rider participating in NEC 2021, will make his/her horse available for International teams for the World Cup Qualifier Competition from 10 – 15 March 2021.

It is mandatory for all NEC participants to make their horses available as per EFI norms. If any participant/Rider/Club/Unit/Team fails to comply to this clause, they will be debarred from All EFI competitions for 3 years.

CAMPING:

18. **Camp:** The camping space for horses and grooms of all participants will be available at the Gautam Buddha University Complex for the duration of the entire NEC Tent Pegging 2021 and Noida Horse Show. Charges for Horse Parking at GBU are earmarked at INR 500/- per Horse for the entire duration of NEC. The Camp for Stabling will Open on 25 February 2021.

19. **Self Containment:** All teams coming to participate in the NEC Tent Pegging 2021 must be self-contained i.e they should bring their own tentage, equipment for camping, cooks and transport, etc. For teams that wish to get Tentage, fodder, food etc may request with the CAMP Commandant at-least 1 week in advance to arrange the same on payment basis.
20. **Ration/Fodder:** All participants are advised to bring maximum quantity of grain/fodder to sustain their horses during their stay in Greater Noida (U.P).
21. **Coggin and Glander Tests:** All rules and instructions issued from the EFI on the subject will be strictly adhered to by all concerned. All horses must produce a valid negative EIA and Glander status (CFT) certificate on arrival to Greater Noida. Coggins and Glanders negative certificate with a validity of a minimum of 15 days on arrival and exit of horses from the camp is mandatory.
22. **Veterinary Commission:** The Veterinary Commission detailed by the Equestrian Federation of India will have full right to examine all the horses participating.
23. **Security Deposit:** All contingents temporarily stabling at the Gautam Buddha University (GBU) will pay **refundable** Security Deposit of INR 10,000 (Ten Thousand Indian Rupees) prior to setting up camp as under. The amount is returned after inspecting the camp area by the The Camp Commandant.

24. Local Administration:

- (i) Local administration will be under the overall supervision of the OIC GBU for civilian, Police, Para Military and Army camps.
- (ii) Camping area for respective contingents will be specified by the OIC GBU. Contingent commanders/private horse owners/Riding Facility (Temp) will be personally responsible to ensure that only specified areas are utilised for camping, stabling and riding. Only tentage will be utilized for camping for men.
- (iii) Separate area will be earmarked for dumping of hay and litter. The contingent commander will ensure dumping at the earmarked area. No hay/litter will be disposed near stabling/camping area.
- (iv) Earmarked water troughs will be utilized. Timings as per local orders will be strictly adhered to. Sick horses will not be watered at the trough.
- (v) Entry and exit of vehicles in the GBU Campus will only be through the main gate. All vehicles will stop at the main gate for checking and verification.
- (vi) Daily orders of local administration will only be pasted on the Notice Board at the Camp/Stabling Area. No individual communication in this regard will be made. A whatsapp group will be made for all Riders, wherein all day to day information would be shared. All participants MUST register their Mobile Numbers with the OIC GBU.
- (vii) Contingent Commanders will earmark persons for collective

area cleaning as per timings which will be intimated daily on the Notice Board.

(b) **Security.** Entry and stabling within the GBU will be regulated by the OIC GBU. No permanent structure will be constructed at the GBU by the equestrian teams both Army and civil. Separate camping area will be earmarked for Army and civilian contingents. They will strictly adhere to the rules and regulations for the camping facility. Any violation of the rules would render the concerned contingent liable to be asked to vacate the GBU premises forthwith.

(c) **Documentation.** Following documents should be submitted for considering the camping facility:-

- (i) Application to be addressed to the OIC/Camp Commandant GBU.
- (ii) Police verification of all civilians (grooms and supervisory staff).
- (iii) Two passport size photographs of civil employees.
- (iv) Passport of horses (issued by EFI).
- (v) Coggins and glanders negative certificate valid for a minimum of 15 days at the time entry.
- (vi) Certificate/affidavit.
- (vii) Indemnity Bond.
- (viii) Undertaking certificate.
- (ix) Details of Horses.
- (x) COVID-19 Self Declaration Form.

(d) **Discipline.**

- (i) No liquor is permitted within the GBU premises. Intoxication, assault or affray will be viewed seriously and will result in the individuals being expelled immediate and inturn vacation of the respective camp with immediate notice.
- (ii) Cooking on fire wood is not permitted.
- (iii) No contingent will tap electricity lines.
- (iv) No horses will be tied to trees nor will support of trees be taken for construction of camp.

(e) **Fire Discipline.** No one is allowed to light fires or smoke within the stabling area. All contingents will be self sufficient in the following :-

- (a) Hand held Fire Extinguisher - Two
- (b) Sand Bucket - Two.

25. **COVID-19 PROTOCOL:** In light of the COVID-19 pandemic, strict protocols and guidelines must be followed in order to ensure a safe and successful conduct of the event. The guidelines for resuming equestrian training and competition activities in a COVID-19 environment issued by the EFI (available of EFI Website) will be strictly adhered to.

A separate set of guidelines will be sent from time to time to ensure safety of all. You are all requested to abide by the same. All decisions made by the COVID – 19 Compliance Officer will be final and binding. It is mandatory for all athletes, parents, trainer, grooms and all accompanying individuals to fill the COVID – 19 Self Declaration Form.

26. **Insurance Cover.** It is recommended that all players/individual take insurance against any injury sustained while participating in the events or practicing at the GBU. It would be ideal for the ponies as well to be covered under some insurance policy. The Camp Commandant may be informed as regard the above while signing the medical declaration. The OC excludes all liability for any injury and/or loss occasioned to any person and/or their property within the premises of GBU, Gr Noida.

27. **Rail Freight.** No rail freight for horses, rail fare or, DA will be paid by the OC to any player/attendant.

28. **Compliance of NADA Rules.** As per the rules in vogue, each participant (both human and equine) are liable for screening for doping at EFI approved events. In view of the above, athlete if approached by NADA to give sample for dope testing are mandatorily required to comply with the same. Any refusal may result in debarment of the athlete..

29. **Veterinary Commission.** The Veterinary Commission detailed by the Equestrian Federation of India for the Event will have full right to examine all the horses participating. It is advisable to have horses checked by the Veterinary Officer on duty before the event start.

30. **Clearance Certificate.** All riders are required to obtain a clearance certificate from the Camp Commandant office during working hours. All outstanding needed to be cleared before they can obtain the same.

MISCELLANEOUS

31. **Hotels & Hostel Rooms:** For teams requiring Hostel Rooms may intimate the Camp Commandant at-least 1 week in Advance. The Fee for Hostel Rooms at GBU would be INR 150 per day. There are other Maintained Guest House Rooms at GBU for which the University administration charges INR 2000 per room per day.

Greater Noida has various categories of **Hotels** from OYO Rooms to 5 Star Hotels. The players requiring Hotel Rooms may request the Camp Commandant to facilitate the same on direct payment to the Hotels.

32. **MEALS at GBU Campus:** An exclusive Canteen would run for Players of National Tent Pegging. The Players/support staff may utilize the said facility on payment basis.
