ADM AND TECHNICAL INSTRUCTIONS

The Chennai Equitation Centre, Chennai is conducting Regional Equestrian League (REL) at Chennai, wef 05 Mar to 07 Mar 2021 in accordance of Rules of the Equestrian Federation of India (EFI).

1. Dates:

The dates for the competition are: **5th March to 7th March 2021**. Tentative programme is as per Appendix A.

2. Entries:

- (a) All entries will be on a proper Entry Form as given in **Appendix 'B'**. Entries not on the prescribed entry form or without entry fee will not be considered. Please e-mail entries to **chennaiequitation@gmail.com**. Please do not send entries by post or courier. Confirmation of receipt of entries will be emailed to the team.

Entries will **not** be accepted without the ENTRY fee.

- (c) **Closing Date for Entries:** Entries will close on **3rd March 2020**.

- (d) **Post Entries:** Post entries will only be accepted up to 24 hour before each event. No entries will be accepted thereafter. Post entry fee will be: Rs.1000/- per exhibit.

3. **Description of Horse:** All entries must have the description, EFI registration number and the name of the horse concerned for REL qualifiers.
4. **Age-specific categories:** All entries for age-specific categories must be accompanied by birth certificates and the age of the rider must be clearly indicated on the entry form. Entries for this category will not be accepted without an attested copy of the rider's birth certificate.
5. **Number of entries:** One horse can participate once in each category of discipline. In one day, a horse can be used only in 2 x Dressage and one Jumping or 2 x Jumping and one Dressage event only.

6. Withdrawal, Change, Transfer or Substitution of Entry:

- (a) **Withdrawal** – The Entry fee of a horse entered for any event will not be refunded if the horse does not participate in the class unless, it is on veterinary grounds and approved by the Vet Commission.
- (b) **Transfer and Substitution** - A horse cannot be transferred from one class to another. A horse once entered in any event cannot be substituted by another horse for any reason whatsoever once the draw of lots has been done.
- (c) **Change of Riders** - Changes of riders will not be considered once the draw of lots for that event has been done.

7. Cancellation: The Organizing Committee reserves the right to cancel any class which has less than four entries, or for any other reason at their discretion. In that case, the entry fee will be refunded.

8. Eliminations: Eliminations may be held for all events depending on the number of entries received.

9. Reporting for Each Class: The first five riders in Jumping must report to the Arena Steward at least 15 minutes before the scheduled start of that event. The Arena Steward has full authority to take appropriate action as per existing rules.

10. Whips/Spurs/Bits: As per EFI and relevant FEI rules.

11. Apparel: Riders should wear white dress shirt with tie and show jacket for all events. White or light coloured breeches are mandatory.

12. Appeals / Objection: A written appeal/objection may be lodged two hours before the commencement of any class and within half an hour of announcement of the results. A fee of Rs.2000/ (Rupees Two Thousand only) must be deposited with the Show Secretary, along with the appeal/objection. The deposit will be refunded if the appeal/objection is upheld.

13. Responsibility: The Organizing Committee accepts no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury to any animal or any other property of the exhibitors/competitors themselves. Neither the Committee nor the Vet/Medical doctor will be held responsible for any first aid or other medical treatment provided.

14. Insurance: Government horses will be insured according to existing regulation. Private exhibitors may make their own arrangements if they wish to insure their horses.

15. Abuse/Cruelty to Horses: As per EFI Technical rules.

16.Camp:

(a) The camp will open 1st March and close on 8th March 2020. All the stable requirements must be received before 20th February.

(b) It will be at the discretion of the participant to choose stabling facility as given below:-

If the OC provides an area wherein the participants will built their own temp shed, charges levied will be max Rs 500/- per horse to take care of electricity, water and cleaning charges thereof.

OR

If the OC provides a temp stable constructed by them for duration of a event or a permanent stable, the charges levied will be max Rs 2500/- per horse.

17.Self-Containment: All teams must be self-contained, i.e., they should bring their own rations, fodder, tent age, equipment for camping, transport, etc. However, hay and straw be procured at the camp.

18.Coggins and Glanders Tests: All horses must produce valid negative EIA and Glanders status (CFT or Mallein) certificate on arrival. Coggins and Glanders negative certificate with a validity of a minimum of 15 days on arrival and exit of horses from the camp is mandatory.

19.COVID-19 Protocol. In light of the COVID-19 pandemic, strict protocols and guidelines must be followed in order to ensure a safe and successful conduct of the event. The guidelines for resuming equestrian training and competition activities in a COVID-19 environment issued by the EFI will be strictly adhered to.

20.VETERINARY COMMISSION. The Veterinary Commission detailed by the CEC, Chennai will have full right to examine all the horses participating.
