

GENERAL INSTRS : EVENTING COACHING CAMP WEF 02 MAR TO 11 MAR 2021
AT ASC CENTRE & COLLEGE, BANGALORE

1. Eventing coaching camp will be held from 02 Mar 2021 to 11 Mar 2021 at ASC Centre & College, Bangalore.

Intimation for participation

2. Selected riders along with their one horse only will intimate the OIC Camp about the total str of contingent and exact time of arrival (ETA) in terms of participant/ adm staff/ syces/ grooms and horses positively by 25 Feb 21 well in advance as per format attached as Appx 'A' to this adm instruction for arrangement of reception.

Camp Arrangements.

3. The Horses and grooms/ Horse handlers accompanying the horses participating for above coaching will stay in the camp which will be located at Polo Det, No 1 Trg Bn (AT), No 1 ASC Trg Centre. The camp will be functional wef 28 Feb 21 (FN) to 11 Mar 21 (AN). All contingents to ensure that they do not reach the Camp before 28 Feb 21 and also make suitable arngs for the return journey well in time since.

4. The OIC Camp will earmark site for each contingent / team / indl. The rep of the contingent/ team/ indl will take over the allotted site from OIC. Camp on arrival and handover the same before departure in the same condition. Any damage to camp site, accn or property will be the responsibility of the OIC of the contingent. The teams should come self contained in all respects for camping arng in respect of their personnel and animal.

- **Note: -No charges for stabling will be levied from the athletes/stakeholders for the duration of coaching camp.**

Accommodation.

5. JCOs and OR will be accommodated in camp area, civilian participants to make own arrangements for accommodation. Accn for participating offrs will be made avlb on sharing basis under the arng of ASC Centre & College. Allotment of accn will however be subject to availability since all courses have commenced and does not constitute right to accn. Serving offrs to come prep to stay in offrs mess guest room if due to any reason the room in mess not avl then they will stay in hotels (on TD).

6. **Civilians.** Civilian participants are requested to make their own arrangement for accommodation & Ration. Camping site near the stabling area of civilian horses will be earmarked for accommodating civilian grooms and support staff. The contingents / indl / riders should be self contained with basic requirement for camping of their personnel, however stables will be made available.

Practice and Exercise Area

7. Suitable arenas will be earmarked for exercise, galloping & practice of horses / riders participating in the competition. A practice and exercise arena will also be provided on the competition ground for warming up the horses prior to the commencement of the event.

Lighting.

8. All contingents are requested to bring their own hurricane lanterns/ petrolmaxes/ gen set etc for emergency use. However, light / power supply shall be provided under camp arrangements.

Ration for Army Animals.

9. Ration for army animals will be drawn ex No 1 Trg Bn (AT), No 1 ASC Trg Centre, Bangalore. Sufficient packing materials for storages of ration including drinking water will be brought by the contingents for horses and men. Contingents will submit their indents for drawing rations and get station order done. Any civil horses participating will make their own arng for animal ration.

Transport.

10. Contingents are advised to be self contained for transport incl tpt for conveyance of animals and stores from respective unit location to Bangalore to back.

Line Gear for Animals.

11. Contingents should bring adequate line gear and picketing gear. Repair of analyze and line gear will be carried out under their own arrangements.

Pitching of Tents.

12. Contingents will pitch their own tents under own arrangements on the are allotted to them in the camp. Efforts to stay in covered accn will be made on arrival.

Families.

13. No families will be accommodated in the camp. Any participant/ supporting staff coming along with their family have to look for their participating contingents, if required.

Fire Precautions.

14. Contingents will be responsible to cater for their own fire fighting equipments and ensure fire preventive measures of their respective areas. The camp commandant however, will detail fire fighting / piquet parties from amongst the participating contingents, if required.

Sanitation and Hygiene.

15. Measures to ensure proper sanitation and hygiene in camp area as well as on the venue of competition will be taken by all contingents including disposal of animals litter by tight packing. All necessary anti malaria precautions will be adhered too.

Discipline

16. All participants, grooms and supports staff coming for the Coaching camp and staying in the camp will be under Camp Commandant for the purpose of discipline. The contingents will ensure that highest standard of discipline is maintained.

Security

17. All contingents will ensure highest level of security of their contingents during their stay in the camp. All Army and civil personnel are warned to be extra vigilant and careful. They will not entertain any unauthorized persons during the stay in Bangalore. Local/station orders on the subject shall be strictly complied with. All contingent Cdrs will ensure that security passes for the civilians accompanying them are collected from the office of Dy Comdt, No 1 ASC Trg Centre imdt on arrival. Camp Comdt will ensure that no civ is permitted to stay in the camp without security pass 24 hrs after his arrival.

Veterinary/ Medical Cover

18. Veterinary cover to animals in the camp will be provided under the arrangements of Officer Commanding, 49 Military Veterinary Hospital, Bangalore, who will establish a Veterinary Aid Post in the camp, OC 49 MVH will be assisted by VO ex No 1 ASC Trg Centre. Medical cover will be provided under the arrangement of SMO, No 1 ASC Trg Centre.

Coggin's Test For Equine Infectious Anemia, Mallein Test / CFT For Glanders

19. All animals are required to be Coggins's tested before their arrival at Bangalore as per latest policy in vogue and carry a certificate to that effect in original. In addition, the animal should have been Mallein tested / CFT negative and exam by Veterinary Officer with certificate stating to be free from any infectious or contagious diseases, which will be produced before entering the camp. Both Coggin's and Mallein/CFT negative certificates **IN ORIGINAL** are to be produced to Camp Commandant on arrival. The minimum validity of Coggin's test on arrival at the camp should be 10 days.

20. Clinical examination of all horses reporting to the camp will be done by a designated veterinary officer to ascertain the health status of the animals.

21. Contingents not complying with the requirement at para 19 ibid or arrival before stipulated date i.e 28 Feb 21 will not be allowed to unload their horses in ASC Centre & College premises and these horses will not be allowed to camp / training areas.

22. COVID Protocol

- (a) In light of the COVID-19 pandemic, strict protocols and guidelines must be followed in order to ensure a safe and successful conduct of the coaching camp. The guidelines for resuming equestrian training and competition activities in a COVID-19 environment issued by the EFI will be strictly adhered to.
- (b) Wearing a mask at all times in ground, camp, show office etc. is mandatory
- (c) All riders, grooms, horse owners, competitors, spectators and parents must carry sanitizes at all times.
- (d) A hand wash sink along with antiseptic soap will be provided by organizers. All riders, grooms, horse owners, competitors, spectators and parents are advised to wash their hands properly.
- (e) All riders, grooms, horse owners, competitors, spectators and parents are requested to maintain a distance of between each other in camp, ground show office and during the coaching camp.
- (f) All riders, grooms, horse owners, competitors, spectators and parents are requested to kindly follow guidelines of State/Centre Govt. for COVID19.
