

**GENERAL INSTRS:SHOW JUMPING COACHING CAMPWEF 25 MAR TO 03 APR
2021 AT ARG STABLES, CHHATARPUR DELHI**

1. Show Jumping coaching camp will be held from 25 Mar 2021 to 03 Apr 2021 at ARG Stables Chhatarpur Delhi.

Intimation for participation

2. Selected riders along with their one horse only will intimate the OIC Camp about the total str of contingent and exact time of arrival (ETA) in terms of participant/ adm staff/ syces/ grooms and horses positively by 20 Mar 21 well in advance as per format attached as Appx 'A' to this adm instruction for arrangement of reception.

Camp Arrangements.

3. The Horses and grooms/ Horse handlers accompanying the horses participating for above coaching will stay in the camp which will be located near AGL Stables. The camp will be functional wef 25 Mar 21 (FN) to 03 Apr 21 (AN). All contingents to ensure that they do not reach the Camp before 24 Mar 21 and also make suitable arngs for the return journey well in time since.

4. The OIC Camp will earmark site for each contingent / team / indl. The rep of the contingent/ team/ indl will take over the allotted site from OIC. Camp on arrival and handover the same before departure in the same condition. Any damage to camp site, accn or property will be the responsibility of the OIC of the contingent. The teams should come self contained in all respects for camping arng in respect of their personnel and animal.

- **Note: -No charges for stabling will be levied from the athletes/stakeholders for the duration of coaching camp.**

Accommodation.

5. All participants are requested to make their own arrangement for accommodation & Ration. Camping site near the stabling area of horses will be earmarked for accommodating grooms and support staff. The contingents / indl / riders should be self contained with respect in tentage and other basic requirement for camping of their personnel.

Practice and Exercise Area

6. Suitable arenas will be earmarked for exercise, galloping & practice of horses / riders participating in the clinic. A practice and exercise arena will also be provided for warming up the horses prior to the commencement of the clinic.

Lighting.

7. All contingents are requested to bring their own hurricane lanterns/ petrolmaxes/ gen set etc for emergency use. However, light / power supply shall be provided under camp arrangements.

Ration/Fooder.

8. All participants should bring their own feed, hay, bedding, grass, etc. for their horses and should make their own provision for staff food. AGL stables will not provide any assistance for the above unless special facilities are being provided for all teams.

Transport.

9. Contingents are advised to be self contained for transport incl tpt for conveyance of animals and stores from respective unit location to Delhi and back.

Line Gear for Animals.

10. Contingents should bring adequate line gear and picketing gear. Repair of line gear and line gear will be carried out under their own arrangements.

Pitching of Tents.

11. Contingents will pitch their own tents under own arrangements on the area allotted to them in the camp.

Families.

12. No families will be accommodated in the camp. Any participant/ supporting staff coming along with their family have to look after their participating contingents, if required.

Fire Precautions.

13. Contingents will be responsible to cater for their own fire fighting equipments and ensure fire preventive measures of their respective areas. The camp commandant however, will detail fire fighting / picket parties from amongst the participating contingents, if required.

Sanitation and Hygiene.

14. Measures to ensure proper sanitation and hygiene in camp area as well as on the venue of competition will be taken by all contingents including disposal of animals litter by tight packing. All necessary anti malaria precautions will be adhered too.

Discipline

15. All participants, grooms and supports staff coming for the Coaching camp and staying in the camp will be under Camp Commandant for the purpose of discipline. The contingents will ensure that highest standard of discipline is maintained.

Security

16. All contingents will ensure highest level of security of their contingents during their stay in the camp. All participants are warned to be extra vigilant and careful. They will not entertain any unauthorized persons during the stay in Delhi. Local/station orders on the subject shall be strictly complied with.

Veterinary/ Medical Cover

17. All participants and horse owners are exclusively responsible for their own veterinary cover and health of their horses. Veterinary assistance to animals in the camp will be provided under the arrangements of AGL Stables, Delhi on request of the horse owners. AGL Stables will not be responsible for any injuries and treatment given to any horse during the duration of this coaching camp.

Coggin's Test For Equine Infectious Anemia, Mallein Test / CFT For Glanders

18. All animals are required to be Coggins's tested before their arrival at Delhi as per latest policy in vogue and carry a certificate to that effect in original. In addition, the animal should have been Mallein tested / CFT negative and exam by Veterinary Officer with certificate stating to be free from any infectious or contagious diseases, which will be produced before entering the camp. Both Coggin's and Mallein/CFT negative certificates **IN ORIGINAL** are to be produced to Camp Commandant on arrival. The minimum validity of Coggin's test on arrival at the camp should be 10 days.

19. Clinical examination of all horses reporting to the camp will be done by a designated veterinary officer to ascertain the health status of the animals.

20. Contingents not complying with the requirement at para 19 ibid or arrival before stipulated date i.e 20Mar 21 will not be allowed to unload their horses in AGL Stables premises and these horses will not be allowed to camp / training areas.

21. Indemnity Bond – All athletes / grooms/ support staff or any other personal must submit the Indemnity Bond to AGL Stables before they or their horses enter the premises. Any personal found in the premises who has not submitted the indemnity bond will not be allowed to ride a horse or come in contact with a horse and will be evicted from the premises immediately.

22. Rules and regulations will be put in place time to time by AGL Stables. All participants and support staff/parents must follow such rules and regulations very strictly.

c) All riders, grooms, horse owners, competitors, spectators and parents are requested to maintain a distance of between each other in camp, ground office and during the coaching camp.

d) All riders, grooms, horse owners, competitors, spectators and parents are requested to kindly follow guidelines of State/Centre Govt. for COVID19.
