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20	013	7	Each member of the Executive Committee, shall assume his office on the following day of the conclusion of the Annual General Assembly Meeting in which the elections were made and will hold the office for a term of two years or till the next Annual General Assembly Meeting, whichever is later. In the case of the President, Secretary General and Treasurer the following restrictions will apply with regard to re-election	Each member of the Executive Committee, shall assume his office on the following day of the conclusion of the Annual General Assembly Meeting in which the elections were made and will hold the office for a term of four years or till the next Annual General Assembly Meeting, whichever is later. All members of the Executive Committee except the President, Secretary General & Treasurer may serve a maximum of two consecutive terms followed by a cooling off period of 2 years. For the Govt employees, the order of DOPT is applicable, according to which any Govt servant cannot hold elective office in any sports Federation/ Association for a term of more than four years or for one term, whichever is less. In the case of the President, Secretary General and Treasurer the following restrictions will apply with regard to re-election.	
20	013	7.1	They shall not hold office consecutively for more than a period of eight year , i.e four terms of two year each.	The President can hold the office for a maximum period of twelve years with or without break i.e. three terms.	

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21	013	7.2	After having held the office consecutively for four years (i.e two terms), they can have an additional two terms of two years each only , if they secure a majority of not less than two-third of the members of the federation attending the general assembly. However, the maximum period which a member can serve in an executive committee should not exceed 8 years/four terms. Such a member, on completion of eight years/4th term will be granted honorary designation equivalent to the position last held by the individual concerned. Such members will not be entitled to contest any further elections. such honorary members, however, will be entitled to attend meetings as when they are invited	The Secretary General and the Treasurer may serve a maximum of two successive terms of four years each after which a minimum cooling off period of four years will apply to seek fresh election to either post. Such a member, on completion of twelve years/3rd term will be granted honorary designation equivalent to the position last held by the individual concerned. Such members will not be entitled to contest any further elections. such honorary members, however, will be entitled to attend meetings as and when they are invited	
21	013	7.3	Add-New Para	In the event of election for the second term, an office bearer (President, Secretary General & Treasurer) who has completed one term shall only be deemed to have been elected if he/she secures a majority of not less than two third of the members of the National Federation/ Association attending the AGM. In the event of failure to obtain such majority, the concerned office bearer shall be deemed to have lost the election. The office would thereafter be filled by election under the normal procedure from amongst candidates other than the office bearer seeking re-election.	

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21	013	10	Elections of the above committee members will be held once in two years or whenever a vacancy occurs during the General Assembly / Extra Ordinary General Assembly from amongst members. All such elected members will serve a two year term. The election process will be guided by bye laws as framed and approved by Executive Committee from time to time.	Elections of the above committee members will be held once in four years or whenever a vacancy occurs during the General Assembly / Extra Ordinary General Assembly from amongst members. All such elected members will serve a four year term. The election process will be guided by bye laws as framed and approved by Executive Committee from time to time.
